

# About Chinese Taipei School (K.L.)

- Established in 1991
- Consists of kindergarten, elementary school, middle school, and high school departments. Adopts the Taiwanese education system, with one academic year divided into two semesters: the first semester runs from September to January, and the second semester runs from February to June.
- In accordance with the Taiwan Ministry of Education, the school follows the Taiwan curriculum guidelines, uses Taiwanese versions of textbooks, and conducts instruction in Traditional Chinese.
- Provides diversified teaching in Chinese, English, and Malay languages.
- Implements small-class teaching, with a maximum of 25 students per class, along with group-based instructional programs.
- Employs teachers of various nationalities.

# Admission targets

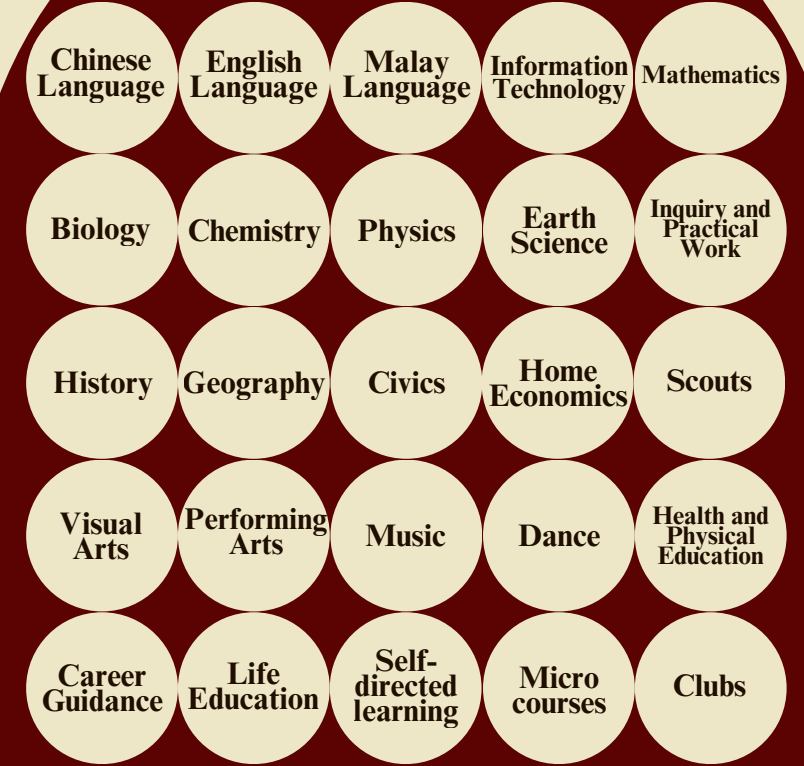
- Enrolls Taiwanese, Malaysian, and international students from elementary school to high school.

# Graduation and further education information

- The school's graduation certificate is recognized by the Ministries of Education in Malaysia and Taiwan.
- Various pathways are available for university admission in Taiwan, including individual application, school recommendation, overseas Taiwan School subject tests, etc.
- For admission to local private or overseas universities, students may apply with their high school results or take additional standardized tests such as A-level, SAT, IELTS, TOEFL, etc.

# Interdisciplinary Learning

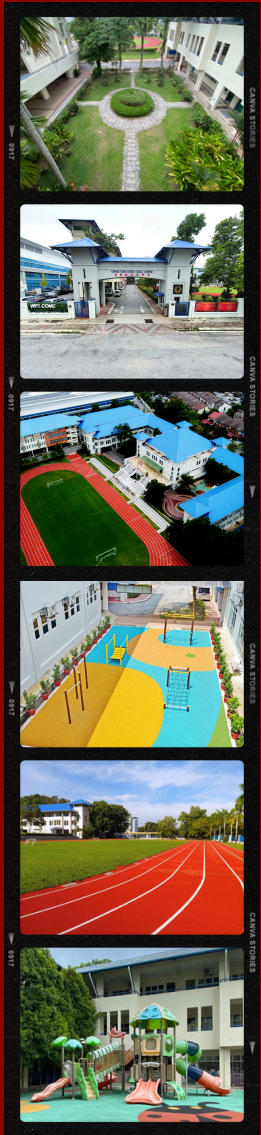
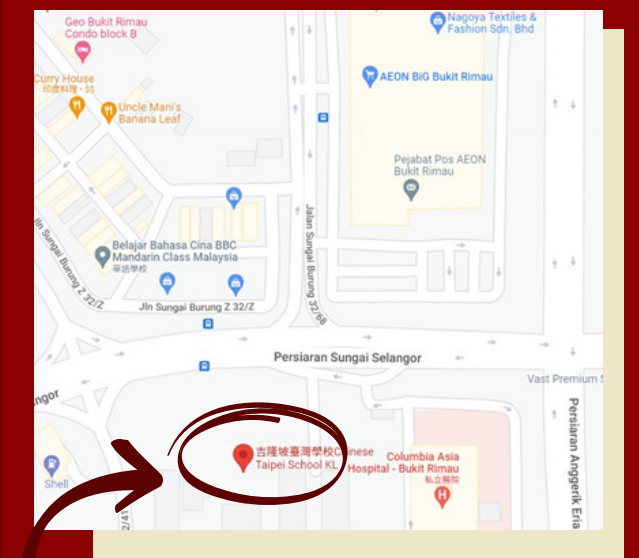
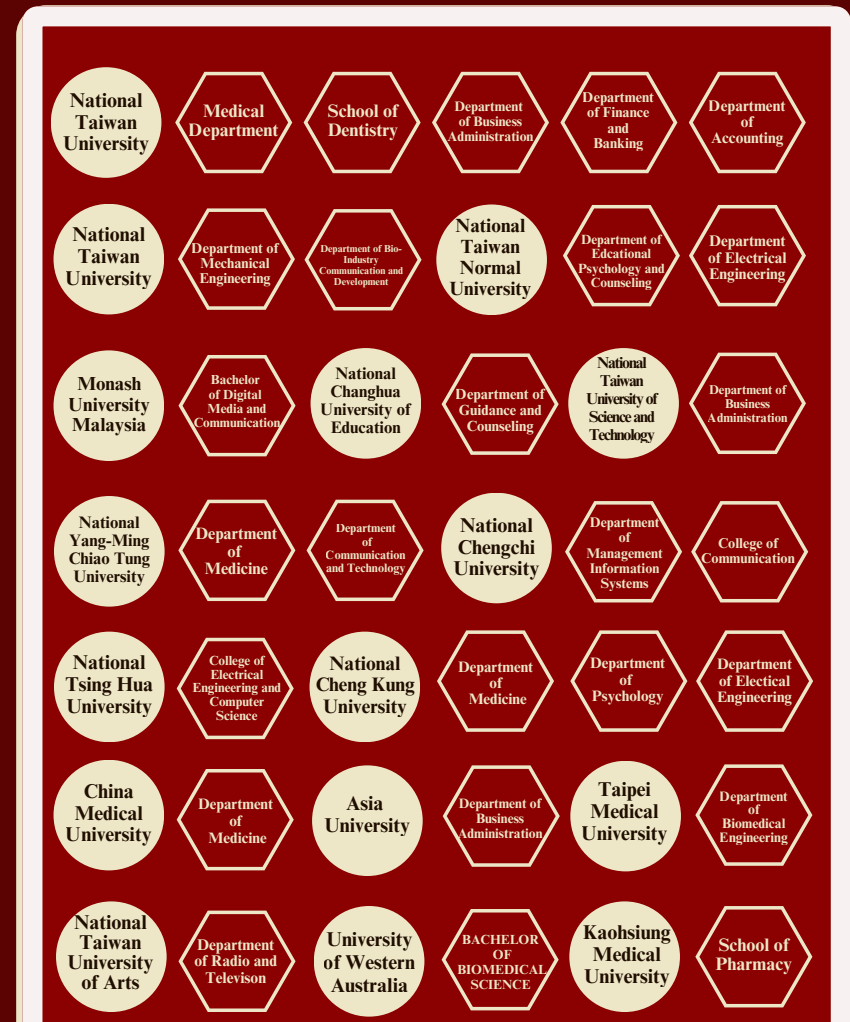

# Forward-looking Vision

- Providing students with opportunities to learn multiple languages and cultivating international talents.
- Chinese Language Curriculum: Using Mandarin as the main medium of instruction, textbooks, and extracurricular books are based on Taiwanese versions. Encouraging students to participate in the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL).
- English Language Curriculum: Elementary and middle school sections use Cambridge English teaching materials, creating a fully English-speaking environment. The high school section uses Taiwanese English teaching materials. Students can take the Cambridge English exams (achieving at least B2 level) as one of the admission criteria for university applications.
- Malay Language Curriculum: Mandatory courses covering Malay language, Malay history and geography, and ethics, deepening understanding of local language and culture.
- Guest Lectures: Inviting experts from Taiwan, Malaysia, and other regions to conduct interactive lectures on various topics.
- Technology Curriculum: Information technology classes start from the primary three, and there are also life technology classes in the middle school section, emphasizing the development of STEAM courses.
- Interdisciplinary Learning: Providing interdisciplinary learning environments to cultivate students' abilities in cross-domain thinking and problem-solving.
